Alphabet Round

Find a relevant word that begins with a certain letter of the alphabet and fits with the category

Anagrams

Work out the words from their anagrams. Words can be chosen to fit any subject or theme you are currently working with.

Celebrity Guessing Game

Using the clues can you guess the name of the celebrity? You can do this using clue's for Bible characters or other famous people to fit a theme or subject. This game has the possibility of becoming out of date, but can be easily updated with a little help from an internet search engine.

Celebrity Lookalike

Many people make money from looking like someone else. Can you tell who these people think they look like or are trying to be? This can be used when looking at themes of identity and self esteem.

Christmas True or False Quiz

18 True or False questions to test your knowledge about the Christmas Story, every answer has an explanation.

Film Invisibles

Screen shots of scenes from famous movies but the people in the scene have disappeared! Can you tell what film it is? Can be used when looking at themes of identity and self esteem, things look different without the characters.

Can you guess what the slogan is advertising? Many things are not only known by their names but by a few words that describe them. Image and identity. This game has the possibility of becoming out of date, but can be easily updated with a little help from an internet search engine or watching the adverts on TV.

Letter Quiz

7 D in a W = 7 days in a week. Sometimes what looks difficult and confusing is quite simple when we take time to look and think about what it might actually mean. Can be used when teaching Bible Knowledge.

Which belongs to which? Matching game. Sometimes its useful to know what comes from where, who the creator is.

This game has the possibility of becoming out of date, but can be easily updated with a little help from an internet search engine and simple photo software.

Can you name the Nursery rhyme from just a few lines? Can be used with all age groups, it's surprising how the older teenagers get into it. Just a bit of fun but can be used if looking at themes of origins or traditions.

Phobias

Can you match the fear to its correct name? Can be used when looking at areas of fear; starting a new school, relationships, bullying etc.

Places to b

These anagrams are names of places that all begin with the letter B. When introducing this quiz you can tell them they all start with the letter B to make it easier or leave them to work it out themselves.

Pop Translation Quiz / TV & Film Translation Quiz

Lyrics from pop songs or TV & Film Titles have been put into a foreign language translator website and then translated back into English. The questions is do you still recognise them. Can be used when looking at how we have come to have the different translations of the Bible. This game has the possibility of becoming out of date, but can be easily updated with a little help from an internet search engine and any internet translation websites.

Price is Right

How much do the things on the list cost? Individually or in teams ask them to work out the cost of each item and then a final total. Hint: when marking, only mark the total price, far quicker! Can be used when looking at themes of money, value, worth, greed.

Sports Logos

You know everything about sport? Can you name the team from their logo? Can be used when talking about team work and representing something and reputation. What does the BB logo mean and what does it mean to wear it?

Stan or Dan

Time for a bit of silliness! Can you tell from the picture if they are a Stan or a Dan? Could be used as an introduction into what can you tell about someone by just looking at them.

Can you name the TV programme from the screen shot?
