Talk: Unconditional Love. – 29 mins good scene before and after

Lilo has seen a falling star and believes that it can give her whatever she asks for. So what does she really want? A friend that won't leave her or reject her, she wants unconditional love and acceptance. Isn't that what everyone really wants? It's great to have family and friends but in the end only God can supply unconditional love and acceptance. Talk: A greater purpose / What I was made for– 45 mins good scene before and after

Stitch was made for destruction, its all he wants in life but now there is nothing to destroy he is empty. He has no higher purpose. People chase many things in life – fame, money ... etc. But if they get it they are left empty (Robbie Williams is a good example but there are stacks of others). A life and a destiny with God is the only purpose which can satisfy – its what we were created for.

Talk: Nobody gets left behind – 1 hour, Good scene after.

Ohama means family, family means no-one is left behind or forgotten. We can be a part of Gods family and that means he will never leave us behind or forget us. He will keep us with him not only in this life but after we die.
